You can find hope in anything because Jesus is better...Jesus is still King. Everything eventually runs out except for what is connect to Jesus. Let him flip your life and fill it up. Time to trust Jesus with every area of your life. Jesus is... Passages: John 2:1-11; 1 Corinthians 2:6-10; Matthew 11:28

Discussion Questions: Take your time and dig into these questions.

What is one thing you really don't like (keep it fun, we'll get serious in a minute)?

Read John 2:1-11. What is one thing that jumps out at you from this story? Why does that jump out to you?

Do you think it is true that "eventually everything runs out that isn't connected to Jesus?" Do you have a personal story that backs backed up your answer?

Read 1 Corinthians 2:6-10. What do you think the "message of wisdom" is that Paul is trying to get the church to focus on?

Trust is often lived out in action. What is one practical change you can make this week to reflect your trust in Jesus?

At the end of the story in John 2 it says that the disciples believed in Him. It is a reminder that you can you can go to church, put on the jersey, even give stuff up for your faith but not really believe or trust Jesus in every area of your life. What is one area of your life you could use a little growth in trusting Jesus more?
