



Sermon-based small groups connect the week to the weekend!

Dig deeper into the talk each week, while getting connected, cared for and known. Challenge yourself to see how the message actually makes sense and applies to your everyday life and do it with people just like you to support you on your journey.

Message Info: Wrecked, 2/7/21- There are things in life we don't want to talk about but probably should. Sin is one of those things. The conversation about sin in church, maybe in your past is usually one absent of grace. That's a huge problem. The bottom line is sin (not just yours, all of ours) wrecks things, but God's grace is way bigger. This message points to our need for grace and doesn't just stop there, it celebrates grace and invites us deeper into it. (Passages: Mark 2:13-17, Romans 5:12-17, John 8:1-11)

Discussion Questions: Take your time and dig into these questions.

What is one thing that you don't want to talk about but probably should? (The funnier the better...no need to get too serious right out of the gate.)

When you hear the word sin what do you think about? What do you feel?

Read Mark 2:13-17. What sticks out to you about this interaction with Jesus? Why?

The actual word sin (hata or hamrtia) in the Bible is defined as missing the mark? Is this a good definition for sin? Why or why not?

Read Romans 5:12-17. This passage is a little bit hard to understand. Paul is making one point over and over about grace and Jesus in contrast to sin. What do you think his main point is?

What is one thing you can do this week to lean into the grace of God?
