



Sermon-based small groups connect the week to the weekend!

Dig deeper into the talk each week, while getting connected, cared for and known. Challenge yourself to see how the message actually makes sense and applies to your everyday life and do it with people just like you to support you on your journey.

Message Info: More Than, 4/11/2021- Thomas is a disciple who had a misunderstood moment stick, labeling him throughout history as “Doubting” Thomas. Thomas is a lot like us. We are more than a bad or unfortunate moment. We are free but not always doing great. The question is: Do you believe God is good? Let your questions be a catalyst to examine your faith and come out the other side stronger. (Passages: John 20:19-29, Psalm 34:8, Hebrews 11:1, 2 Corinthians 5:6-7)

Discussion Questions: Take your time and dig into these questions.

What is a nickname you have had? How did you get it? Did you like it or hate it?

What's a moment that stuck to you that was or still is challenging to get past?

Do you think God is good? What makes you think that?

Read John 20:19-29. What sticks out to you from this passage? Why did that stick out to you?

What do you think the difference is between doubt being a catalyst that can deepen your faith or an excuse to go your own way?

Read Psalm 145:9 and Psalm 34:8. What do these verses teach us about the goodness of God?

What are some practical ways you “taste and see” that the Lord is good this week?

Group Challenge: Send three encouraging text message to someone that doesn't attend your group this week. Be specific.
