Message Info: The Heart, 7/25/2021- Lots of different people gather to hear Jesus. Both the notorious sinners and the notoriously religious. The notorious sinners were drawn to Jesus, so why aren't they drawn to us? This message is about getting unstuck in the weeds of religion and finding the heart of God. A story about sheep to show us that the lost sheep is the object of God's affection. Let's be like Jesus. (Passages: Luke 15:1-7, John 10:1-21)

Discussion Questions: Take your time and dig into these questions.

Did you ever have a moment in your life where you missed the most important thing because you were stuck in the details or the weeds of life? What happened?

Ready Luke 15:1-7. What sticks out to you about this passage? Why?

Why do you think notorious sinners were drawn to Jesus in this passage and throughout scripture?

What do you think it means to be a "lost sheep"? Do you know of any verses in the Bible to back up your answer? (This part might take some team work?)

What is God's heart toward lost sheep?

Do you see ways in which God has been pursuing you? Can write one down or share it with the group?

Read John 10: 1-21. What sticks out to you in this passage and why?

What is your favorite thing about the Good Shepherd from this passage.

Group Challenge: How can you go out of your way to help someone this week?
