**Message Info:** Out Of The Ordinary , 4/24/22 - The hero had ordinary beginnings but the right kind of heart. Being faithful in the small things God places in front of you matters. Building character and practicing consistency and faithfulness is an essential step in experiencing victory. Learn to be content without being settled. Learn to find joy in where God has you right now. Learn to be faithful in the small things. (Passages: 1 Samuel 17:17-20, 1 Corinthians 1:26-30, 2 Corinthians 12:8-10, Philippians 4:11-13)

**Discussion Questions:** Take your time and dig into these questions.

Read 1 Samuel 17 together. This is the chapter this 6 week series will walk through. Then read 1 Samuel 17:17-20 and 1 Samuel 16:7,18). What sticks out to you from these passages about David and why?

How would you describe David's heart?

Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-30. What are some real life examples of this verse? Why do you think God chooses to use common, ordinary people to do great things throughout scripture?

What are some areas of your life you have been discontent with?

What do you think the differences are between being content and settling?

Read Philippians 4:11-13. How can you learn to be content without settling?

What are some small things you can practice being faithful in this week?
